Water Quality Infrastructure Grant



THE PROGRAM

The Water Quality Infrastructure Grant (WQIG) program is intended to provide financial assistance to qualified business entities that have an operational need to improve existing or create new wastewater systems that serve their enterprise. Wastewater system projects serve the public purpose by improving water quality and positively impacting the surrounding environment.

- The project must create jobs with salaries exceeding the county average by 15% (currently \$49,175/year)
- Available throughout Volusia County, but the municipality where the company facility is located must provide a 20% match
- Award distribution occurs over a period of 4 years to ensure workforce retention.

THE RULES

- The business entity must fall within a Volusia County Targeted Industries sector. These sectors include Life Sciences, Information Technology, Aviation/Aerospace, Financial/Professional Services, Defense, Manufacturing, Clean Energy, and Emerging Technologies.

THE BENEFITS

- Promotes creation of new, good-paying jobs
- Water quality improvements benefiting the business and surrounding communities
- Catalyst for business attraction and growth

Grant terms, based on daily capacity are as follows:

10,000 Gallon/Day Capacity Up to \$250,000
20,000 Gallon/Day Capacity Up to \$500,000
40,000 Gallon/Day Capacity Up to \$750,000
